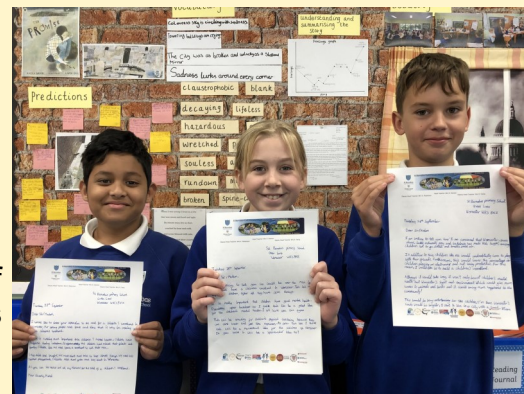


Exciting News for St. Barnabas School!
