### Coronavirus Update #2 January 14th 2022

Numbers of cases in **most classes** remains **very low** or there are none at all. Numbers in Year 2 are currently high and both classes have been returned to a bubble. Parents of children in Year 2 have been asked to do daily LFTs for 7 days. Children can attend school if their test is negative. All those who have tested positive are in **self-isolation** and we send them **get well** soon wishes!

We remain vigilant on a daily basis and continue to report to parents whenever they need to know that their child is likely to have been a close contact and what they need to do. Thank you to everyone who has been so supportive with wearing face coverings on site, testing when needed and helping your child with remote learning. Let's hope things start to improve again soon. Please:

- 1. Continue to be vigilant at home.
- 2. Keep children home & arrange a PCR test if they shows signs of being unwell with coronavirus symptoms.
- 3. Support us by doing a daily LFT if we notify you that your child has been a contact.
- 4. Continue to report results to school.
- 5. Contact the school office if you have any queries about remote learning or need to loan a device if your child is at home self-isolating. Work will be set via Seesaw on the second day of absence or as soon as possible. If your child is unwell they do not need to complete the work and it can be saved until they are feeling better.
