Launch

Children will have a Hive session looking at Anglo-Saxon artefacts.
Experience what life was like in Anglo-Saxon Times.

Explore

The children will research the Anglo-Saxon period of British History and discover how they influenced society at that time.

Celebrate

Children will choose their own way to present what they have learnt about the Anglo-Saxons.

- Excitable Edgar
- Vipers Comprehension skills: Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explain, Retrieval, Summarise.
- Weekly reading for enjoyment, promoting good 'book talk'.

Writing

Writing will be based on The Iron Man, Anglo-Saxons, Wing (which will be a friendship focus) and Excitable Edgar.
The children will be:

- Writing a diary entry from Hogarth's return home after he had caught the Iron Man.
- Write a newspaper report on the arrival of the Iron Man
- Creating a non-chronological report about the Anglo-Saxons.
- Writing an apology letter from Edgar.
- Retell a scene from the Excitable Edgar.
