



Results of Green Lane Pre-school Exit Survey at the end of Academic Year 2022-2023

2.0 Overview of what is working well from parents:

For a second year running the survey is overwhelmingly positive and clear that the pre-school teaching team and management team have listened to the views of parents and carers from previous surveys and face-to-face discussions.

74% (17/23) parents and carers responded to the survey, which is a 15% increase from the previous year. Parents had the option of completing via Microsoft forms or as a paper copy.

20 children transferred from Green Lane Pre-School to St. Barnabas.

- 1 pupil transferred to Fort Royal Special School.
- 2 pupils transferred to another local Primary school.
- 1 pupil moved out of the UK just before the end of term and did not complete the survey but passed on lovely comments in a letter before leaving.
 - 1. Safeguarding: 100% parents and carers feel their child had been kept safe extremely well.
 - 2. **Communication: 100%** parents and carers feel the pre-school **listen to parents** and understand their viewpoint **extremely well.**
 - 3. 82% (14/17) parents and carers feel they have been kept informed of their child's progress and next steps better than expected and the remaining 18% as expected. This is an increase of 7% from last year. The pre-school team work hard with this.



- 4. **Communication** between pre-school and home has remained rated as **5.00 average** (maximum score).
- Teaching & Learning: 100% parents and carers feel the pre-school offered their child an excellent range of inside and outside learning opportunities, an increase of 6% from 2022.

6. In line with 2022, 82% parents and carers (14/17) said their child had made better than expected progress and the remaining 18% felt it was as expected. No parents or carers felt their child had made poor or slow progress.

- 7. **82%** parents and carers (14/17) said their child had been prepared for starting school **better than expected**, with the remaining 18% as expected- also virtually identical to 2022.
- 8. **100**% felt that **partnerships** (Ofsted area for development 2018) was **completely effective**, a slight increase from last year and pleasing as this is something we have all worked to improve.
- 9. As in 2022, the **overall rating** for Green Lane pre-School was **5.00** (maximum score) and **100**% parents and carers were completely likely (maximum score) to **recommend** Green Lane pre-school to a friend, neighbour or colleague.
- 10. Comments relate to strong settling in procedures, significant increases in communication and language skills, developing and improving self-confidence and early childhood development. Several parents and carers also commented that they liked the way the staff allowed and encouraged their child to 'be their own person' and develop their own interests and ideas. Parents and carers feel happy and confident leaving their child at Green Lane, knowing that they will be well cared for as well as developed socially and academically.
- 11. Comments include **high level of support** with **preparation for school**, including for working parents who couldn't always be there.
- 12. A high level of satisfaction from parents who had moved their child from another setting following closure.
- 13. As in previous surveys, many comments relate to the **quality of staff** and the positive impact those **strong**, **consistent relationships** have had on their child's wellbeing, learning and progress. **Love and care** has been mentioned several times in the survey but this is also something that is regularly fed back to me by parents and carers. We believe this exemplifies our whole school Christian ethos and values and recognizes that very young children learn best in an environment where they feel secure, safe, cared for and able to explore with confidence.
- 14. Parents and carers can see the **educational improvements** their child has made.

3.0 Comparison of survey year on year:

Another very strong survey showing an extremely high level of parent satisfaction across a range of important areas.

Areas that were previously highly rated have either maintained or shown further improvement.

Improvements made in response to previous feedback, for example, an increase in Tapestry uploads to help keep parents informed and involved.

Other areas that show improvement in the survey are for parents and carers rating highly being kept well informed about their child's progress and attainment plus, the provision of an excellent range of inside and outside learning opportunities.

4.0 Overview of suggestions for improvement from parents:

All comments show a very high level of satisfaction with the pre-school and many say they can't make any suggestions for improvement. One areas for improvement was raised relating to holding more open sessions/opportunities for parents and family members to be invited in. There are no repeat themes.

5.0 Outcomes for the future:

- Continue to ensure excellent partnerships and via the agreed partnership actions (regular drop in sessions, have a key person for each child, write reports, share home and school achievements using Tapestry and have 'Wow Moments' slips).
- Plan in a regular drop-in/stay and play session for families so they can see and experience the range of different indoor and outdoor learning opportunities but also enjoy time spent at pre-school with their child and the staff. These need to be carefully managed for safeguarding reasons and also have to be at the right time of the term so as not to unsettle very young children.
- Plan in more parent support sessions such as e.g. potty training, developing speech and language, ideas for play. This is done well via the Key Person on a 1:1 basis but could be scope for more family learning sessions.
- Continue to work with the PCC re installing a secure outdoor scooter park for preschool families who walk to school.
- Continue to monitor the lunchtime arrangements/quality of food with Red Hen Cookery.
- Continue to ensure high quality teaching and learning opportunities both inside and outside, ensure best use of outside area, The Meadow and school grounds to give youngest children opportunities to explore the outside.
- Ensure continued high quality early years CPD to keep all staff up to date and informed about the EY curriculum and best practice as well as statutory safeguarding, paediatric first aid, food hygiene training.
