


Reading

Maths


- Multiples of 10

Geography

How did the eruption of Mount Vesuvius impact the people and place of Pompeii? Children will:

- Identify Human and Physical Characteristics of a location
- Understand how some of these aspects have changed over time.
- Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography-volcanoes.

The children will:

Science – Skeletons and Muscles
