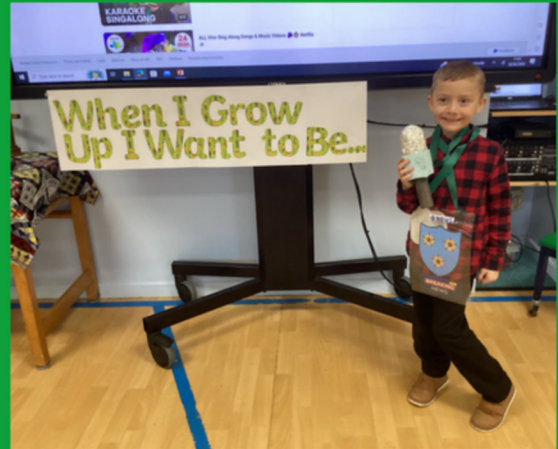


On Friday 2nd February, we celebrated 'Number Day'.
