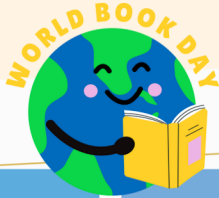

WORLD BOOK DAY THURSDAY 7TH MARCH

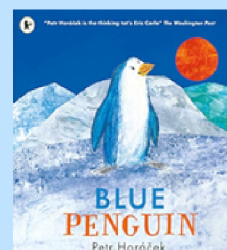
Let's celebrate our love of books and reading!
