Attendance Days missed over a Percentage school year

100% 0 days 95% 10 days 90% 20 days- 4 weeks!

85% 30 days-half a term! 80% 40 days- 8 weeks!

We know that regular school attendance helps children achieve well, make friends, have strong relationships with adults and enjoy school more.

When children miss too much school they fall behind, can become anxious, feel left out of friendship groups and then don't want to go to school.

HOW CAN I HELP MY CHILD?



Only keep your child at home if they are really too sick for school

Always contact school (phone, ParentMail or email) if your child is going to be absent. You must contact school for EVERY day of absence.



Please DO NOT take your child out of school for holidays or family visits. These will not usually be authorised.

On very rare occasions there are reasons why term time absence is authorised. Please be aware that you may be fined for unauthorised absence.



. Be organised and arrive on time. Set routines that the children can help with.

Let school know of any medical appointments and keep children away from school for as short a time as possible. Please make appointments out of school time whenever you can.



Attendance below 90% is classed as 'Persistent Absence' and your child will be put on an Attendance Support Plan.
