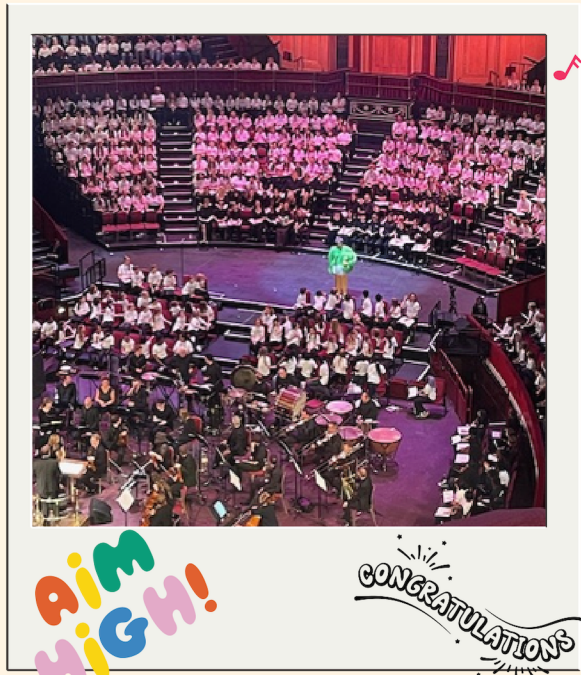
They have been working incredibly hard for months now to learn some challenging music, including singing the iconic music, Carmina Burana 'O Fortuna' .
