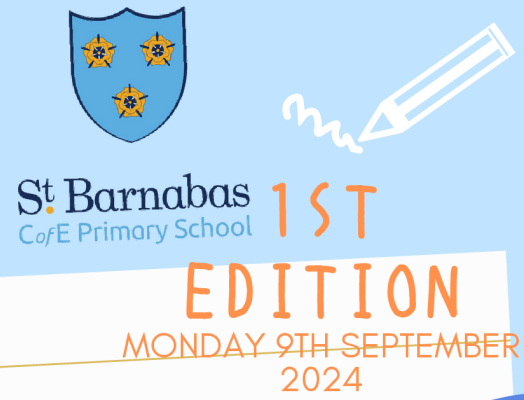


St. Barnabas CE Primary School SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

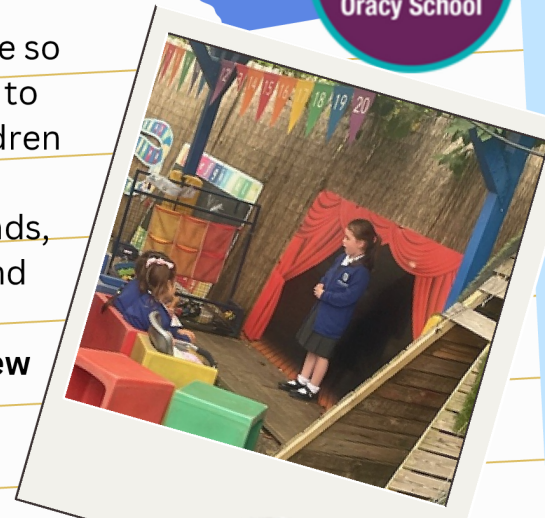
New children have already started settling in, making friends, learning and playing together well both inside and out and getting to know their **routines** and the **staff team**.
