Reading

Reading plays a vital part in our learning and retention of knowledge. Over this half term, the children will be exposed to a wide range of texts. They will:

- Explore vocabulary, practise inference skills, make predictions, develop explanations, improve retrieval and summarising skills (VIPERS)
- Apply reading skills linked to the class texts

Writing

Writing will be based on our class text The Lost Happy Endings. We will focus on a range of age appropriate skills such as:

- Writing a character description and settings
- Planning and publishing a piece of writing focusing on audience and purpose
- Using a wide range of devices, such as punctuation, to build cohesion.
- Writing a narrative from character view

Maths

Our key areas of learning will be:

- Multi step addition and subtraction problems
- Find missing numbers
- Multiples
- Factors
- Prime numbers, square numbers and cubed numbers
- Multiply by 10, 100 and 1000
- Divide by 10, 100 and 1000
