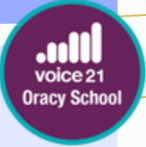

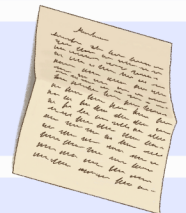

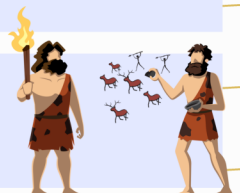

Don't forget to ask your child what they are learning about Anti-Bullying through the week.

During **Anti-Bullying Week** all children will **discuss and explore** what bullying is and how to **respect and appreciate difference in others**.

They will learn how to **get help** if they or someone else is being bullied and about how not to be a **bystander**.

They will practice being **assertive without being physical** if something goes wrong!

**Anti-bullying** means showing **kindness and respect to others**. Older children will learn about **on-line bullying, protected characteristics and how to disagree respectfully**.

This will be done in lots of different ways- through **story, art, drama, theatre, debating, games and teamwork** and in an age appropriate way.

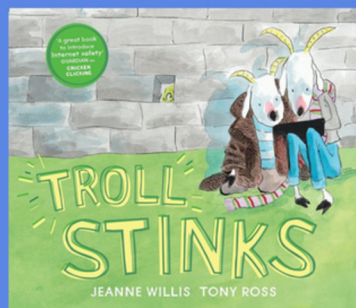
