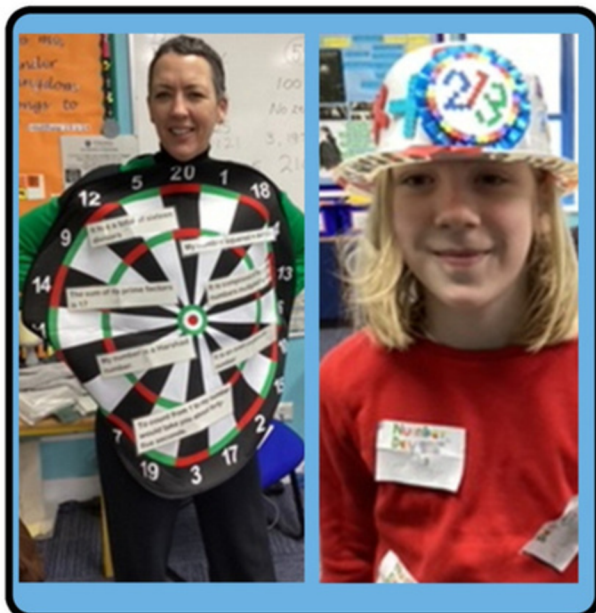
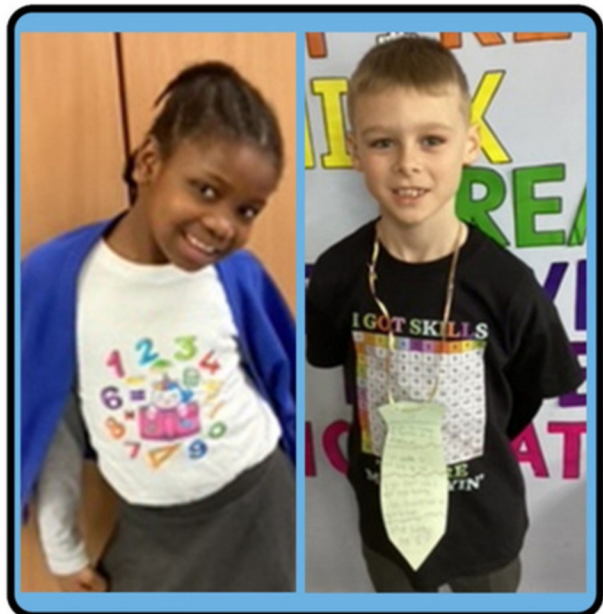
Thank you for all your brilliant Maths Missions completed over half term - we have loved celebrating them in school.
