



Top Tips-The secret to success is practising little and often. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? Your child will be bringing home some “Hearts in Love” to share their maths learning with you!

Use practical resources – Use items around the house to find different ways of making 10, e.g. one blue sock and nine white socks. One and nine make ten.

Ask questions during daily routines, for example we have 6 apples and 4 bananas in the fruit bowl, how many pieces of fruit altogether? Four and six make ten.
