To know decimal number bonds to 1 and 10

By the end of this half term, children should be able to recall these facts instantly.

0.6 + 0.4 = 1	3.7 + 6.3 = 10
0.4 + 0.6 = 1	6.3 + 3.7 = 10
1 - 0.4 = 0.6	10 - 3.7 = 6.3
1 - 0.6 = 0.4	10 - 6.3 = 3.7
0.75 + 0.25 = 1	4.8 + 5.2 = 10
0.25 + 0.75 = 1	5.2 + 4.8 = 10
1 - 0.25 = 0.75	10 - 5.2 = 4.8
1 - 0.75 = 0.25	10 - 4.8 = 5.2

This list includes some examples of facts that children should know. They should be able to answer questions including missing number questions.
