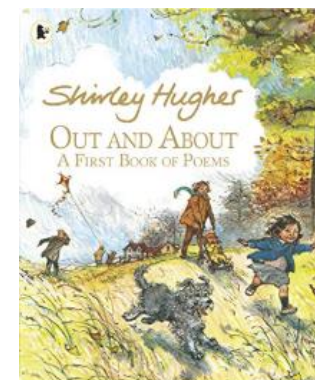

Oracy

The children will:

- Learn and recite a poem by heart
