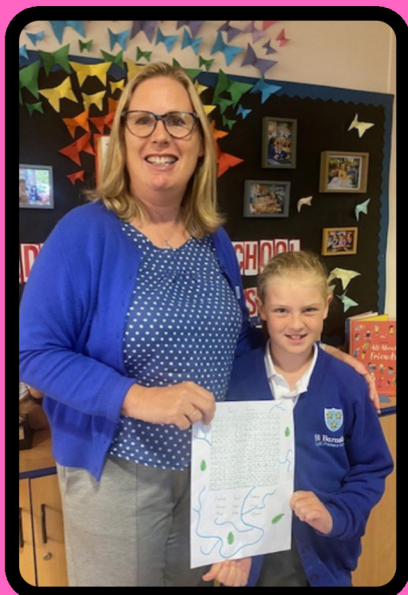
## Super September!
