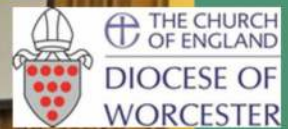
## Year 5 Visit Worcester Cathedral

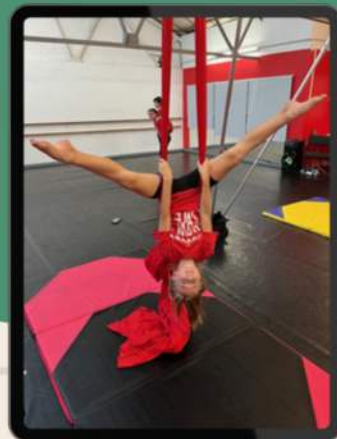
